**Aim:** Who is the narrator? How can we characterize him/her?

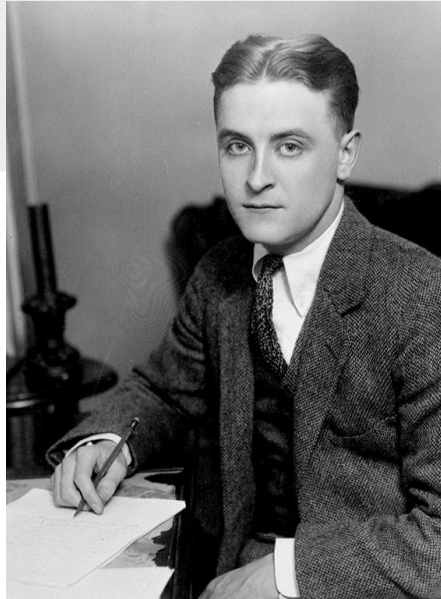
**Stretch:** "Whenever you feel like criticizing anyone, just remember that all the people in this world haven't had the advantages that you've had."
