PRE-COLLEGE PROGRAM

Eligibility: Current 10th graders from NYC public high schools who demonstrate financial need and who are interested in going to college for visual art or design.
*Financial need is determined by the general guidelines outlined by the NY Higher Education Opportunity Program (<http://heop.org/guideline>)
*We seek students who are highly motivated to develop themselves as artists & designers despite limited opportunities in art, design and college guidance.

Program: Students take a wide range of visual art & design courses at Parsons the New School for Design. They explore exciting art and design careers and college options, and learn how to apply to the colleges of their choice, with a focus on art/design programs.

Length: 2.5 years, January 2016 through June 2018 on Saturdays and during summers. Attendance to all programming is mandatory.

Cost: **FREE**; full tuition to the Pre-College Academy and Summer Intensive Studies programs, materials, transportation, mentoring, advising, and 7 college credits (upon successful completion).
*This is a college prep program and not a college scholarship.

An essay & letter of recommendation must be emailed;
A mandatory information session;
All eligible applicants will attend a studio session, an interview, and asked to submit proof of household income, a high school transcript, and to show samples of their artwork.
