- Did you complete your TAP application?
- Did you get an appointment for the CUNY assessment/placement exam(s)?
- Did you take the CUNY assessment/placement exam(s)?
- Have you selected the college you plan to attend in the FALL?
- Have you submitted your commitment response form and deposit to the college you chose?
- Did you notify Ms. Terraferma which college you decided to go to?
- Did you notify the other schools you got accepted to that you will not be attending?
- Did you check to see if the college you chose requires any supplemental information?
- Did you complete your college immunization form?
- Did you apply for any scholarships?

### **CORRESPONDENCE FROM COLLEGES**

Do not disregard any mail you receive from the colleges you have applied to. They often want more information from you before they make a decision and/or before you attend in the fall. Remember to read all the information.

### **FINANCIAL AID**

Be sure to apply for financial aid – FAFSA and TAP. If you have already applied to a college or university, you will need to file your financial aid application ASAP.
