- 2) Score above **75** in **ELA regents & ELA Common Core**

Students who are not college ready may be subjected to taking remedial classes in college

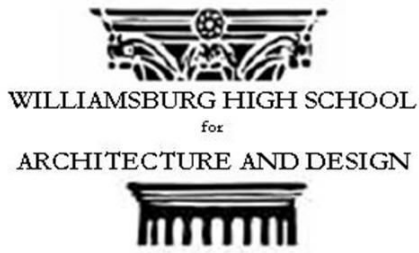
