What's happening this month?

You should have received an email or formal letter from all your schools regarding your admissions decision. You should review all your acceptances and financial aid packages before selecting your college. **Decisions should be made by May 1**st **2022**.

- Check your email (inbox, junk folder, spam folder, etc) for acceptance letters and next steps.
- Forward your acceptances (letters or emails) to Ms. Terraferma (terraferma@whsad.org)
- Create Your **CUNY First Account** to check the status of your applications and next steps under the "to do" section. Accept or Decline your colleges in CUNY First.
- Check the NEXT STEPS and TO DO LIST in your CUNY First Account.
- Please note, **Guttman Community College** requires applicants to complete a mandatory <u>Group Information Session</u> to be considered for <u>admission</u>.

- Make sure you submitted your FAFSA (Federal Aid) and TAP (NY State Aid) Applications.
- Submit your **2022-2023 FAFSA Application!** Review your SAR Report for errors and Expected Family Contribution (EFC) (www.fafsa.ed.gov)
 - STEP 1: OBTAIN YOUR FSA ID

 - Both the student and 1 parent should obtain an FSA ID
