END OF THE SEMESTER

COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

ACCEPTANCE LETTERS have started coming in!!! Check your email (and SPAM folder!) every day. Email the letters (good and bad) to Ms. T. (terraferma@whsad.org)

Not sure if your applications are complete?

- **CUNY**: Create Your CUNY First Account to check the status of your applications and next steps.
- For CCNY School of Architecture: The *Creative Challenge* is due <u>February 1st!</u> See post on Google Classroom for application and upload instructions.
- For Guttman Community College: You must attend a *Group Information Session* to be considered for admission. Register: https://guttman.cuny.edu/admissions/information-session/
 - Upcoming Sessions (Online: January 4th @ 3pm or In-Person: January 17th @ 5pm) or you can do the session at your own pace with your Grizzly Path login information.
- **SUNY**: Log into your SUNY Portal and make sure you submitted your *EOP Application* if applicable.
- **Common App/School-based Applications**: Confirm with each institution that they have received all your materials.
- Copies of all acceptance letters (or emails) need to be given to Ms. Terraferma.

Haven't applied to college yet?

There is still time to apply. See Ms. Terraferma or a Creative Connection coach ASAP.

FINANCIAL AID

The 2024-2025 **FAFSA** application launched on December 31st. The application is now available for you to complete at www.fafsa.ed.gov for assistance, you can make an appointment with Ms. Terraferma or a Creative Connections Coach.

STEP 1: OBTAIN YOUR FSA ID https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch

Both the student and one parent (contributor) should obtain an FSA ID

STEP 2: GATHER YOUR INFORMATION (HERE IS WHAT YOU NEED)

- Your and your parents' Full name, DOB, social security numbers (SSN) and email address (same as the only you used to make the FSA ID) (Resident Card info if applicable)
- Date of legal residence (DOB or when you moved to NY)
- Parent's marital status and educational status (did they complete attend/complete college)
- Your and your parents' 2022 W-2 forms and other records of money earned
- Your and your parents' **2022 federal income tax returns** (including all applicable schedules)
- Your and your parents' current bank statements and other information regarding their income.
- List of colleges you applied to for fall 2024 admission.

STEP 3: COMPLETE THE FAFSA APPLICATION

• After the student submits their section, the parent/contributor will receive an email to complete their section. After the application has been processed, you will receive an email.

STEP 4: REVIEW YOUR FAFSA SUBMISSION SUMMARY. EMAIL THE SUMMARY TO MS. TERRAFERMA OR UPLOAD IT TO THE GOOGLE CLASSROOM.

After you submit your FAFSA, your NEXT STEP is to Complete TAP. TAP is the NY STATE TUITION ASSITANCE PROGRAM (i.e. NYS Financial Aid)
