What is happening this month?

At this point, you should have received all your college admissions decisions (letters or emails – check your spam folder). You may have to log into the school's admissions portal (such as CUNY First) to check your application status. If you have not heard anything, stop by the guidance office and we can call the college directly. Please forward your acceptances to Ms. Terraferma (terraferma@whsad.org).

You should review all your acceptances and financial aid packages before committing to a college. Once, you review all the information with your families, you will need to confirm your spot. To reserve your spot, you often need to pay a *commitment deposit*. The deadline to submit your commitment is normally May 1st. Check your college's website as many schools have extended the deadline due to the FAFSA delays.

 - USE your 2022 1040 Tax Return

 - USE your 2022 IT-201 NY Return
